WHAT IS A BUSINESS CERTIFICATE?

A business certificate is a registration of a business that is being conducted within the town of West Boylston.

It is commonly referred to as a "d/b/a form" or "Doing Business As". Its purpose is primarily for consumer protection and public information purposes. Essentially, the public has a right to know who "is" a particular business, since a customer will not know who "owns" the business simply by the name of that business.

WHO MUST FILE A BUSINESS CERTIFICATE?

Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 110 § 5, states that any person conducting business under any title (business name) other than the real name of person conducting the business must file a Doing Business As certificate with the Town Clerk's Office. A person is defined as an individual, a partnership or a corporation.

Exemptions to filing are allowed under 110 § 6 if the corporation is doing business in its true corporate name, or if a partnership is doing business under any title, which includes the true surname of any partner. Certain other exemptions exist for trust and limited partnerships.

MUST I DISPLAY A COPY OF MY BUSINESS CERTIFICATE?

The law states that copies of your certificate must be available at the address at which the business is conducted, and shall be furnished on request during regular business hours to any person who has purchased goods or services from such business.

WHAT IS THE PENALTY IF I DO NOT FILE A CERTIFICATE OR STATEMENT?

The law states that a fine of not more than three hundred dollars will punish violations for each month during which the violation continues.

HOW LONG ARE THE CERTIFICATES GOOD FOR?

Business certificates are valid for a period of four (4) years from the date of its original filing. They must be renewed every four (4) years for as long as the business remains active.
